For Bhature:

- 2 cups maida
- 2 tbsp rava
- 1 tsp sugar
- ¼ tsp baking soda
- ½ tsp salt
- 2 tbsp oil
- ¼ cup curd
- Water for kneading
- Oil for frying

- 1 cup chana (soaked overnight)
- 2 tea bags
- ¹/₄ tsp baking soda
- 1 tsp salt
- 3 cups water
- 2 tbsp oil
- Spices (bay leaf, • cardamom, cumin, kasuri methi, garam masala) 1 onion, 1½ cup tomato puree
- Ghee for tempering

- sugar, baking soda, salt, and oil.
