





CURRENT AFFAIRS



DAL BATTI CHURMA

- WHOLE WHEAT FLOUR - 2 CUPS
- GHEE - 4 TBSP
- SALT - ½ TSP
- WATER - AS REQUIRED (FOR KNEADING)

FOR DAAL:

- SPLIT YELLOW MOONG DAL - ½ CUP
- SPLIT CHANA DAL - ½ CUP
- TURMERIC POWDER - ½ TSP
- RED CHILI POWDER - 1 TSP
- CUMIN SEEDS - 1 TSP
- HING - A PINCH
- GHEE - 2 TBSP
- SALT - TO TASTE
- WATER - 3 CUPS
- CORIANDER LEAVES - FOR GARNISH

FOR CHURMA:

- WHEAT FLOUR - 1 CUP
- GHEE - 3 TBSP
- JAGGERY POWDER OR SUGAR - ¼ CUP (ADJUST TO TASTE)
- CARDAMOM POWDER - ¼ TSP

PREPARATION STEPS

- PREPARING THE BATTI
 - IN A LARGE BOWL, MIX WHEAT FLOUR, SALT, AND GHEE. RUB THE GHEE INTO THE FLOUR UNTIL CRUMBLY.
 - GRADUALLY ADD WATER AND KNEAD TO FORM A STIFF DOUGH.
 - DIVIDE THE DOUGH INTO SMALL BALLS (ABOUT THE SIZE OF A GOLF BALL).
 - PREHEAT THE OVEN TO 200°C (390°F). BAKE THE BALLS FOR 25-30 MINUTES OR UNTIL GOLDEN BROWN, TURNING THEM OCCASIONALLY.

5. FOR AUTHENTIC TASTE, YOU CAN ALSO ROAST THEM OVER A TRADITIONAL CLAY OVEN OR OPEN FLAME.

6. ONCE BAKED, LIGHTLY CRUSH THEM USING A ROLLING PIN FOR EASIER SERVING WITH DAAL.

2. PREPARING THE DAAL

- WASH AND SOAK THE MOONG DAL AND CHANA DAL FOR 30 MINUTES.
- BOIL THE DALS IN 3 CUPS OF WATER WITH TURMERIC AND SALT UNTIL SOFT.
- IN A SMALL PAN, HEAT GHEE, ADD CUMIN SEEDS AND A PINCH OF HING. FRY UNTIL AROMATIC.
- ADD RED CHILI POWDER AND POUR THIS TEMPERING OVER THE COOKED DAAL. MIX WELL.
- GARNISH WITH FRESH CORIANDER LEAVES.

3. PREPARING CHURMA

- CRUSH THE BAKED BATTI OR MAKE FRESH SMALL DOUGH BALLS.
- ROAST THEM LIGHTLY IN GHEE UNTIL GOLDEN AND CRISP.
- CRUSH OR GRIND THE ROASTED BATTI INTO COARSE CRUMBS.
- MIX JAGGERY POWDER (OR SUGAR) AND CARDAMOM POWDER INTO THE CRUMBS.
- SERVE WARM.

- PLACE THE HOT BATTI ON A PLATE.
- POUR DAAL OVER THE BATTI AND DRIZZLE SOME GHEE.
- SERVE CHURMA ON THE SIDE AS A SWEET COMPLEMENT.
